**Moora Wildflower Drive**  
 Moora stands on the junction of two important and very different botanical districts, where the underlying geology has produced different soil types and so very different plant communities. To the east lies the very ancient rocks (200 million years or more) of the Western Australian Shield, one of the oldest land surfaces on earth. It has fertile red soils and has largely been cleared for farming. To the west are the younger rocks of the Dandaragan Plateau, covered with poor sandy or gravelly soils. The fault line is marked by the course of the Moore River. The Moora Wildflower Drive is designed to show you these regions and their plants.

**Watheroo National Park & Jingemia Cave**  
 Created in 1955 with an area covering 44,473ha. The park is very rich in many varieties of wildflowers. Nearby Jingemia Cave is a shady picnic site. The Cave is formed in chert, an unsealed rock that leads to a vegetation community in the hill very different from the surrounding areas.

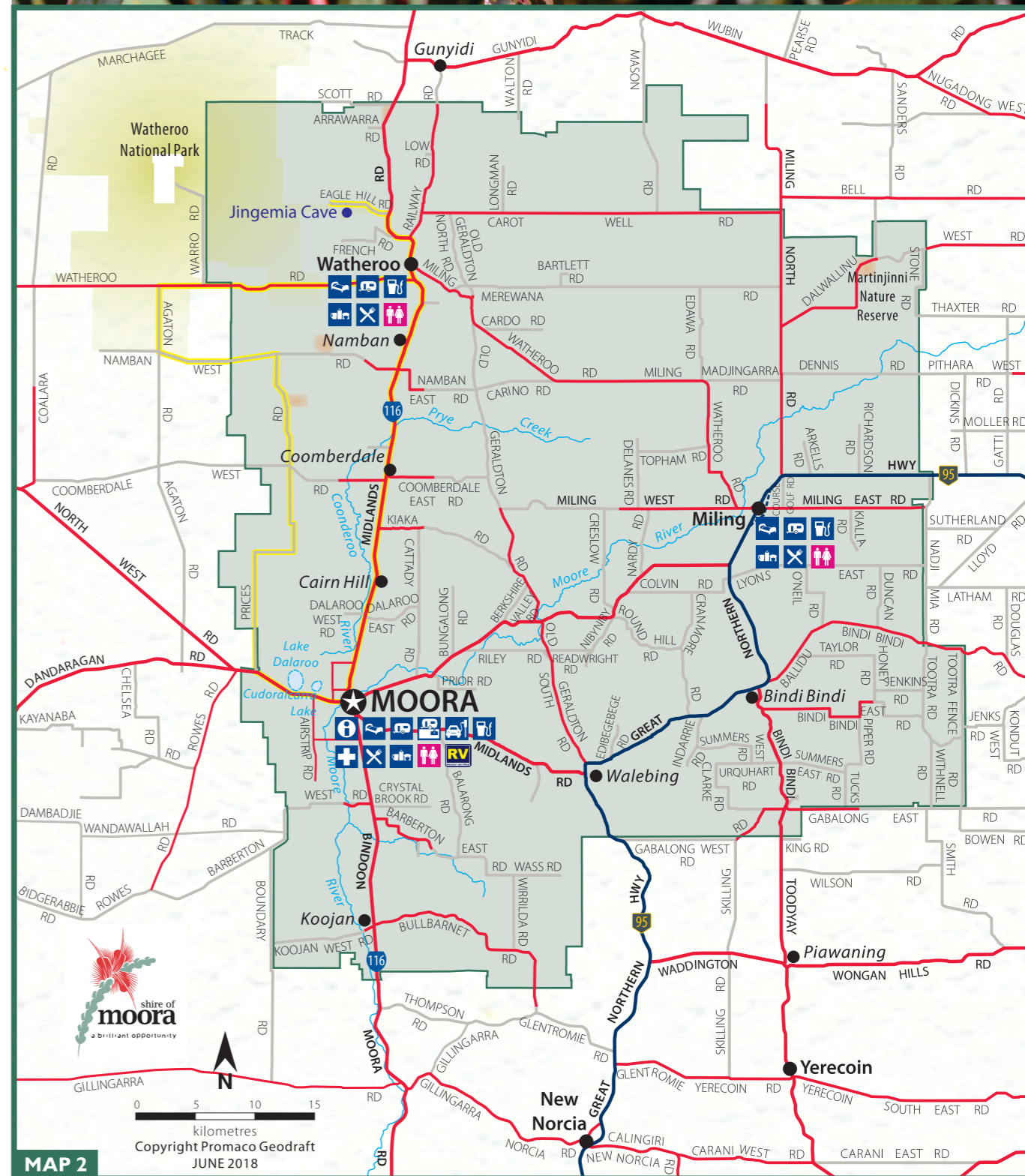
**Moora Museum**
