Notes to the Enrolment Eligibility Claims Form

1 When to use this form	The Corporate Body may make a claim to register nominees using this form at any time. However, if the Corporate Body wants to be represented on the roll for a particular election it must give its claim form to the Shire of Moora more than 50 days before the election date
2 Who should use this form	You should fill in this form if you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • own or occupy³ rateable property in a district but are not on the residents roll in that district; or • qualify under clause 12 of Schedule 9.3 to the <i>Local Government Act 1995</i> ; and want to be able to vote at Shire of Moora elections. It should be noted that all or a majority of people who own or occupy the property may nominate two persons who are on either on the State or Commonwealth electoral roll, to enrol as electors. If a proposed nominee is on the residents roll for the district, they are automatically enrolled to vote.
3 Who is an occupier	To qualify as an occupier the people concerned must have a right, under a lease, tenancy agreement or other legal instrument, to be in continuous occupation of the property for at least the next 3 months. Proof of your right of occupation may be requested.
4 Silent address	If having your address on the register or on the roll would put your safety, or that of your family, at risk you may ask the Chief Executive Office not to show your address on the register or on the roll. To do this you must give to the Chief Executive Officer a statutory declaration setting out the reasons why you do not want your address shown on the roll.
5 Rateable property	If you own or occupy more than one property in the electorate give details of them all. Add additional pages if necessary.

7 Qualification under clause 12	To qualify under clause 12 of Schedule 9.3 to the <i>Local Government Act 1995</i> you must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • own or occupy rateable property in the electorate; • have been on the last electoral roll prepared under the <i>Local Government Act 1960</i> for that electorate; and • have owned or occupied rateable property in the electorate continuously since that roll was prepared.
8 Nominations	A nomination must be made in writing and be signed by all or a majority of the owners or occupiers in accordance with the Local Government (Elections) Regulations 1997. If the same people own or occupy more than one property in a district, a nomination applies to all those properties.
9 Duration of enrolment	If this Enrolment Eligibility Claim is accepted it will expire in accordance with section 4.33 of the <i>Local Government Act 1995</i> (this will usually be 6 months after holding of the second ordinary election after your claim was accepted). If you wish to continue to qualify to be represented on the roll after that, all or a majority of the owners or occupiers will need to make another enrolment eligibility claim.
10 Confidentiality	Your date of birth, phone and fax numbers and email address supplied in this form will be kept confidential and will be used only by the Shire of Moora and the Western Australian Electoral Commission for the purpose of preparing local government electoral rolls.
11 Where to send your form	When you have completed and signed this form, send it to the Chief Executive Officer of the Shire of Moora, PO Box 211, Moora, WA 6510. You may send it by post, by fax or by other electronic means so long as it is capable of being printed in its entirety, including a signature. If you send it by fax or electronically you should check that it has been received.
12 Change of Address/Details	If you are currently enrolled as an elector for the Shire of Moora and you wish to advise of a change of address or any other enrolment details, please do not complete this form. Simply advise the Shire of Moora in writing of the amended details to your enrolment.
