TERMS & CONDITIONS

SCOPE

The Shire of Moora War Memorial Swimming Pool is operated in accordance with the *Health (Aquatic Facilities) Regulations 2007* (WA), the *Civil Liability Act 2002* (WA) and the Code of Practice for the design, construction, operation, management and maintenance of aquatic facilities January 2020. It is governed by the Department of Health Regulations and Royal Life Saving Western Australia advice.

SAFETY

The Shire of Moora War Memorial Swimming Pool is a Watch Around Water facility. Patrons must adhere to the following:

- Children under 10 years must be accompanied into the centre and constantly supervised by a parent/guardian while at the centre. The parent/guardian must have a clear view of the child at all times.
- Children under the age of 5 must be accompanied in the water by a responsible person aged 16 years and over.
- Unsupervised children (of any age) will be removed from the water if the lifeguard is concerned for their safety or due to unruly behaviour.
- Children must be a minimum of 10 years or stage 5 swimming to go on the pool inflatables.
- A minimum ratio of 1 adult to 2 children aged 5 years and under, and 1 adult to 4 children under 10 years of age.

All Patrons are to adhere to the Lifeguard's instructions, directions and pool rules.

All pool rules apply during use of the Moora War Memorial Swimming Pool and failure to comply may result in the event being cancelled or future use of the facility being declined.

Members using the Pool do so on the understanding that they believe that their state of health and physical condition is such that their wellbeing will not be unduly affected when using the equipment and apparatus. The Shire of Moora encourages members over 35 years to seek medical clearance prior to commencing an exercise program at Shire of Moora Memorial Pool.

Members are encouraged to train in pairs or groups.

CONDUCT & BEHAVIOUR

Management reserves the right to refuse entry, cancel a membership or request a member to leave the premises if:

- the member does not behave in a responsible manner,
- is under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol or
- does not adhere to the general conditions of entry.

48 HOUR COOLING OFF PERIOD

Members reserve the right to cancel their membership, without providing a cause or reason, in writing within 48 hours immediately after they enter into the membership agreement.

EMERGENCY

In case of an emergency all users must follow the instructions of the Pool Manager and exit the facility.

The Pool must be cleared of swimmers if necessary and will be the responsibility of the hirer to account for their party.

DISCLAIMER

1. I agree to comply with all rules, conditions and directions stipulated in this Terms and Conditions document regarding the facility and its equipment use and personal behaviour of members whilst using the Pool.

2. To the best of my knowledge, I believe that my state of health and physical condition is such that the proper use of the Pool facilities in accordance to the Terms and Conditions which apply thereto will not pose any risk to my health and wellbeing.

3. I acknowledge and agree that my use of the services, facilities, equipment or apparatus of the Pool will be undertaken at my own risk.

4. Exercise is demanding and there are innate risks associated with an exercise programme and the gym environment. Participating in exercise at the Shire of Moora Memorial Swimming Pool may cause serious injury, paralysis or death. I participate in exercise at my own risk.
