Hay Bales Festival is back in 2026 and will be delivering an unforgettable night of live music, open-air vibes, and a true regional atmosphere. The evening will feature live performances from a talented lineup of local artists, including Annie Johnson, The Vanzetti Sisters, Mike Edwards, along with our headlining act, Jessica Mauboy!

Hay Bales is the spectacular finale of the Moora Music Project, a community-driven initiative showcasing the incredible talent within our region. Before Jessica Mauboy takes the stage, audiences will enjoy an impressive 70-minute set performed by 31 local musicians, brought together into 10 unique groups including: Piano ensemble, Guitar ensemble, Four family bands and a Youth Guitar Ensemble. They will be joined by the Badgingarra Women's Choir, Moora Primary School Choir, Miling Primary School Choir, and St Joseph's Primary School Choir, who will unite as one for a truly unforgettable performance. All will perform with backing from the Massed Choir. Participants have already begun rehearsals and are being supported by the Shire of Moora, Australian Baroque, and Mirabilis as they prepare for this remarkable opportunity.

# MOORA AERODROME UPGRADES

Significant upgrades are progressing at the Moora Aerodrome, with major improvements now taking shape. Asphalt aircraft turning areas have been installed at both ends of the runway, along with a 62m x 20m extension to the runway asphalt. Four new water storage tanks have also been installed, providing a total capacity of 1,132kL, with pipework and pumps to be completed. In addition, a substantial 32m x 26m aircraft hangar is currently under construction and nearing completion. These works strengthen local infrastructure, enhance safety and usability, and support vital aviation services in our region, including the Royal Flying Doctor Service and the Department of Fire and Emergency Services. Together, these upgrades represent another important step forward for Moora and its growing aviation capability.


