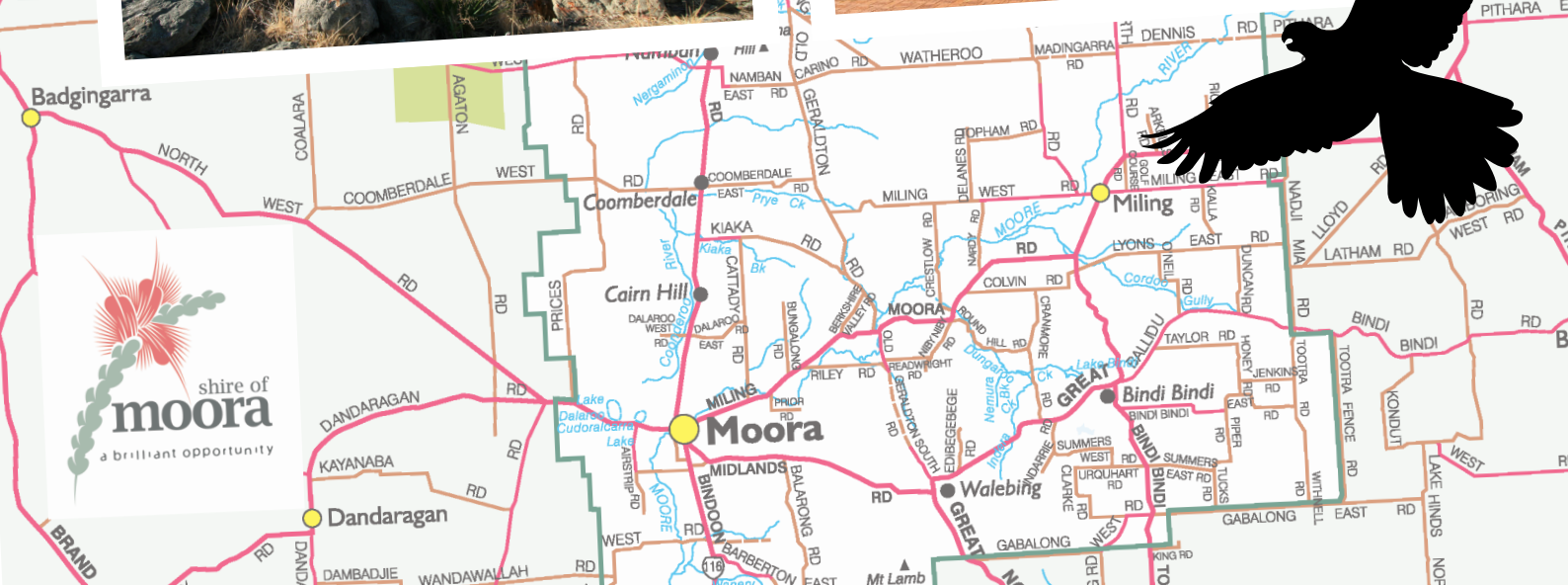

## MOORA MUSIC PROJECT

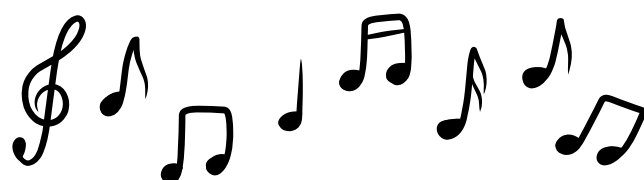

Each of them courageously shared their personal experiences and the tools that have helped them navigate challenging times.

A heartfelt thank you to the Hamilton Family for not only hosting but beautifully setting up the venue, to Neville and the Rotary Club for cooking up a fantastic BBQ, and to George, Louis, and little pup Kevin for the grand tour. ## CORELLA POPULATION MANAGEMENT IN WATHEROO

The Shire of Moora have engaged an appropriately qualified contractor to assist with the management of Corellas in the Watheroo region.

The contractor will be carrying out a corella cull for the management and control of corellas within our area. A corella cull has been put in place due to the significant damage these birds cause to local infrastructure, native vegetation, and community amenities.

The Shire acknowledges that culling of any wildlife is potentially distressing to some people. Unfortunately, it is a measure of last resort which must be taken to protect the larger environment, to minimise the increasing damage these species are causing throughout the community, and to reduce the pest corella population to levels that are determined to be ecologically sustainable.

# Quick Guide to Grant Impact

## Understanding, planning, and measuring grant impact

### LOTTERYWEST GRANT WRITING INSIGHTS SHARED

On Monday, 16 June, the Shire of Moora welcomed 30 passionate locals and regional changemakers to the Impact Café workshop at Jeanne D'Moore, a practical and inspiring session designed to support community members in their grant-seeking journey. Participants travelled from near and far - including Cervantes and Jurien Bay - to take part in this valuable learning opportunity.

The workshop was facilitated by Melanie Bainbridge, Senior Manager Knowledge & Insights at Lotterywest, who guided attendees through the principles of impact design, effective grant applications, and how to turn great ideas into fundable, community-driven projects.

In addition to the engaging presentation and group discussions, attendees received a comprehensive slide pack and additional tools to continue developing their projects post-workshop. The session highlighted the importance of outcomes-based planning and encouraged collaboration across community sectors.
