## 2025/2026 Rates Information

### **Message from the President...**

On Wednesday 27 August 2025, Council adopted the Shire's 2025/2026 budget. In adopting the budget, Council retained the finance model applied in each of the previous two financial years. An overall 5% rate increase has been applied resulting in an average annual rate of \$180.32 per property.

The budget for 2025-26 financial year supports a material capital works programme that includes the ongoing Wheatbelt Secondary Freight Network upgrades that support the sustained economic growth of the region. The provision of new residential housing for the Western Australia Country Health Services remains a pivotal project that ensures quality residential accommodation is available for hospital and health staff.

The budget continues for support the ongoing development and upgrading of Shire assets including roads, water and sewerage plants and pipe networks, the aerodrome and community recreation facilities. The Shire is excited to continue the expansion of its early childhood partnership with Telethon Speech and Hearing and the continuation of its successful Hay Bales Concert series.

The Council of the Shire of Moora and its dedicated staff is committed to its pursuit of diversity, development of economic opportunities, services and infrastructure that ensure the Shire's long-term growth, attractiveness as a place of business development and place for families to live and thrive.
